

Why ASEAN?

ASEAN has set a renewable energy target to reach 23% by 2025; So far, renewable energy accounts for only 6% of the total in the ten ASEAN countries. Southeast Asia is home to wind energy “goldmine” just waiting to be tapped.

Why Vietnam?

Vietnam plans to deploy 6000MW cumulative capacity of wind power by 2030, which will occupy 2.1% of the country's energy structure, per the revised Master Plan #7.

Resource strengths



- Tropical monsoon climate
- Coastline of 3,260 km
- 2,600+ km² potential areas for offshore wind power
- 7+ m/s wind speed at an altitude of 100 meters.

Government-driven



- FiT: \$8.5 cents/kwh for onshore wind
\$9.8 cents/kwh for offshore wind
- Duty-free for import machinery and materials
- Lower corporate income tax rate and reduction
- Reduction of land royalty and rent for wind power operators




